第一部分：回答問題 Answering Questions

1. I have projects once a month. They're usually group discussions in class. For some courses, I also do final reports at the end of semester.
2. I prefer working in a group because I like to work with others and hear different opinions. Also, I'm not very good at doing presentations, so I usually let other group members do it.
3. Joanne, here's a tip for you: listen to them first. It'll make people think that you value their points of view. This way, they'll be more willing to listen to your ideas.
4. Yes. I missed a class last Monday because I overslept. The class started at eight, and I slept through the whole morning.
5. I don't think it's a good idea. Some students might need money for school and are busy doing part-time jobs. It's more important to look at students' homework or exams.
6. Hi, Mike. I heard that you're often late for class. If you're having trouble with the course, I can lend you my notes if you want.

第二部分：表達意見 **Expressing Opinions**

- (1) The chart shows what students at Jintai University do at the school library. About 50% of students study, followed by borrowing books and online resources, about 45% and 35%. Most students at my university study at the library, so I think they use it in similar ways.
- (2) Generally I prefer to study in a quiet environment to help me focus better. That's why I find the library to be an ideal place to study. It allows me to concentrate on my studies. It also provides a variety of resources such as books and online resources.
- (3) I really like our school library because it has a lot of good books and online resources. It's clean and organized. The library staff are also very friendly and helpful. However, I think there are some things that the library could do to make it even better for students. For example, it could get more copies of books that are in high demand, or have more computers and printers available for us to use. Also, it would be great if it could stay open longer so that students can study even when it's late.

第三部分：摘要報告 Giving a Short Presentation

- (1) The passage argues that online learning is the future of education and is gaining popularity. Many teachers are teaching online, and studies show that students prefer online courses to in-person ones. The author recommends that universities should allocate more resources to online teaching. The chart shows that after taking online courses, students' preferences for in-person courses fell a little below 60% and their preferences for online courses rose a little. The key difference between the passage and the chart is the change in the proportion of students' learning preferences before and after taking online courses. The passage states that students prefer online courses more than in-person ones. However, the chart shows that the preference for in-person courses remains higher even though the preference for online courses increased to more than 40%.
- (2) As a college student in Taiwan, I partially agree with the passage. Online learning has definitely become more popular in recent years, and it has its advantages, such as flexibility and convenience. However, I don't think universities should direct more resources toward online teaching than in-person teaching. While online learning has its benefits, it also has limitations, such as the lack of face-to-face interaction with teachers and classmates, which can be crucial for effective learning. In my opinion, universities should strike a balance between online and in-person teaching to provide the best possible learning experience for students.
